



SHASTA COUNTY MINI MAKER FAIRE

STEAM Art Challenge Entry Guidelines

Purpose: To challenge students to create an aesthetically creative sculpture that incorporates artistic skill, structural engineering, and scientific knowledge.

Exhibit Dates: At the Maker Faire on Saturday, November 12, 2016

Awards Announcement: 3:00 P.M. at the Maker Faire

Jury: Local artists in Shasta County

Eligibility: Open to everyone, ages 9-18 or has a college ID. Each sculpture must have a way to place a 2" by 2" piece of dry ice and 2 inches of water on the bottom of the piece. The project must be under 10 pounds and must be 24" x 24" x 24", or smaller.

Certificates of Award: Top three sculptures will be awarded within each age group: 9-11, 12-14, 15-18 and College Level (no age group, but must be attending college) **AWARDS:** Awards will be given to the top 3 places in each of the four age groups. The Shasta Arts Council is supporting this challenge with a cash award for first place in each of the four age groups and a one year membership to the Shasta Arts Council for each of the top 3 places in each of the four age categories.

Delivery for Judging: Sculptures must be submitted to **Lura Wilhelm**, art teacher at University Preparatory School located at 2200 Eureka Way, Redding, CA 96001. **Entries will be accepted from 3:15-5:00 P.M. starting on Monday, October 31st and ending on Thursday, November 3rd.** Only one entry per student will be allowed. Each entry must be submitted with a completed entry card and a label, with the entrant's **name and school** clearly printed on it.

Judging: Entries will be judged on Saturday, November 5, 2016.

Notification: Entrants will be notified via email by November 7, 2016 if their entry is accepted.

Pickup of All Works: Every sculpture must be picked up at University Preparatory School in room 132 from 3:15-5 P.M. on Monday-Tuesday, November 14th and 15th. Please contact Lura Wilhelm if you are unable to pick up the projects within this timeline. Email: lwilhelm@suhsd.net

Liability: All reasonable care will be given to all sculptures submitted. However, all entries will be handled and displayed at the artist's risk. The Maker Faire will not be responsible for loss or damage to any entries in its custody.

STEAM Art Challenge

Objective: Challenge students to create an aesthetically creative sculpture that incorporates artistic skill, structural engineering and scientific knowledge.

Example: Paper mache a two liter soda bottle and paper mache an object around the bottle. With the bottle, make sure there is a place to insert the dry ice and water, as well as a place for the vapor from the dry ice to escape. Please note... You do not have to create this out of paper mache.
